STATIONERY 2022

In order to ensure that you do not incur unnecessary expenses, we hereby provide a list of stationery that will be required in 2022.

From the 14 October 2021, the clothing shop will have these items available as complete packages per grade at R385 for Grade 4, R535 for Grade 5, R545 for Grade 6 and R580 for Grade 7.

We strongly recommend that each learner acquires a HAT dictionary and an Oxford South African English School Dictionary (for home use), as these are long-term investments and can still be used in high school. For spelling and language development to occur, it is essential that every learner has access to a dictionary. However, it is not necessary to bring dictionaries to school as there are new sets of dictionaries in every classroom.

Learners receive the following items and you do not have to purchase them:

- Textbooks and front covers for workbooks

All stationery must be clearly marked and brought to school on Wednesday, 19 January 2022 (files excluded). All textbooks must be covered in thick plastic, and are only on loan for one year. If learners lose or damage these books, which are school property, they are responsible for their replacement.

Tipp-Ex (correction fluid) is forbidden and will be confiscated if brought to school. Many problems have been encountered in this regard, as some learners apply it to desks, books and stationery.

It is compulsory for all Grade 4-7 learners to purchase the prescribed school bag. This bag is only available at the clothing shop.
